

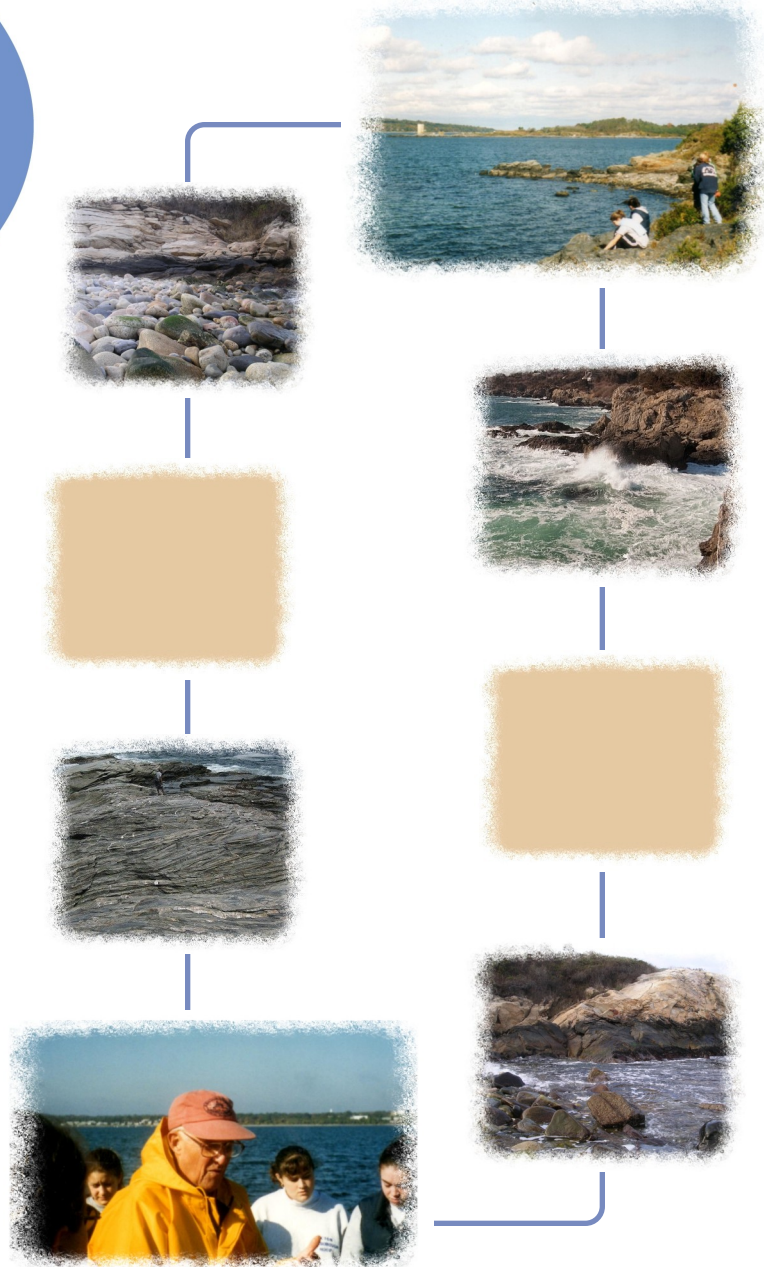
June 17-June 22, 2012
